basic supplies:



materials: paper (big)

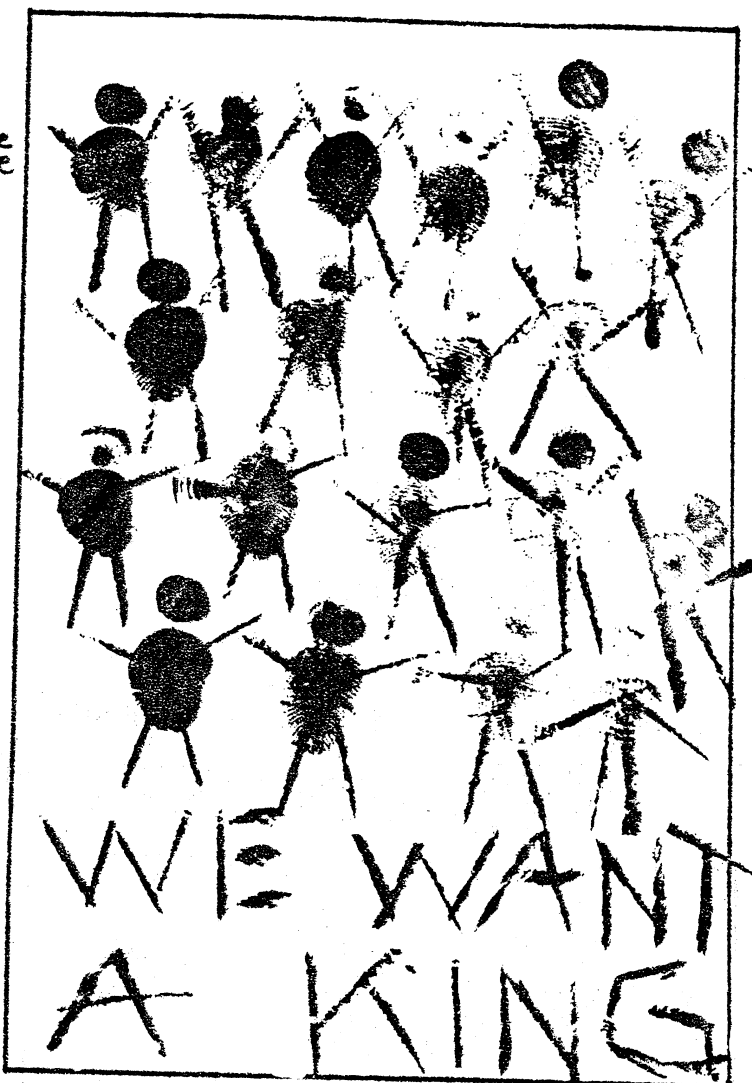
- ink pads (or paper towel soaked with paint) (easier to wash off)
- potato or rubber stamp letter set from lime store
- knife
- smocks

teacher preparation:

- either cut out the eight letters out of potato or cut pieces with which to construct letters, also pieces to print limbs with, or use rubber stamp letter set
- make sure the paint-sponges work well

procedure: wear smocks

- children print people "just like everyone else" with index fingers and pinkies, and pieces of potato
- print the words



notes: if printing letters with potato is too difficult, use markers
