basic supplies:



materials:

- map of Holy Land
- large sheet of posterboard
- colored pencils
- blank labels (sticky) (optional)

teacher preparation:

- draw the bare outline of the Holy Land on the posterboard
- know where the places mentioned in Samuel 13 are on the map

procedure:

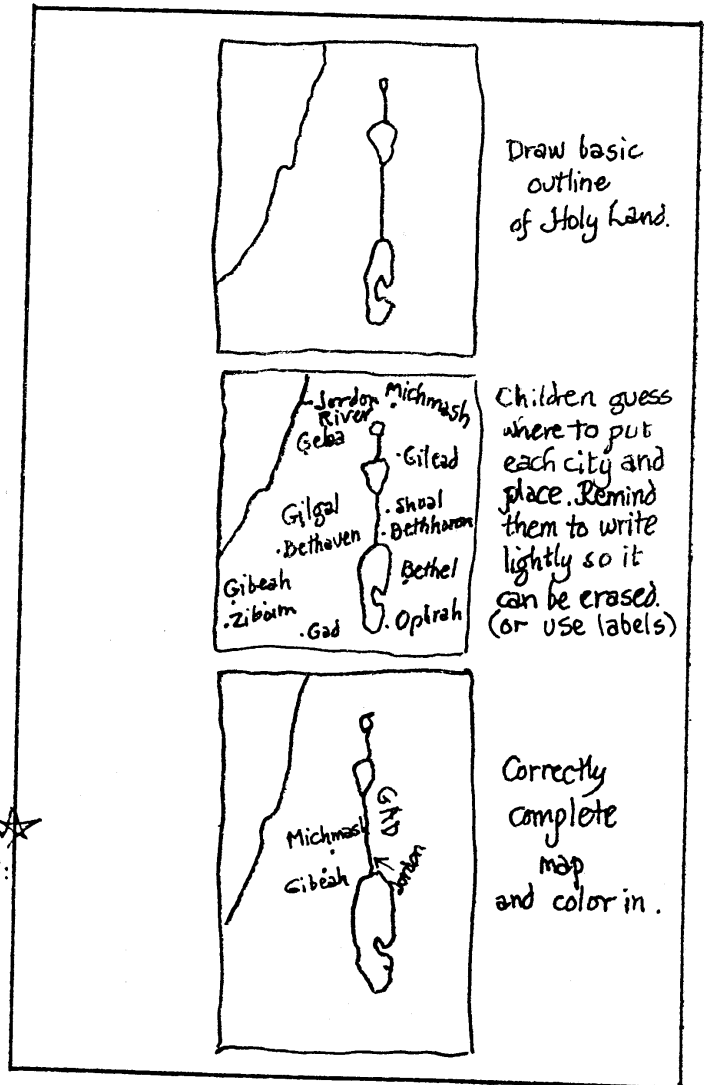
- first, each child "does what is right in his own eyes" and without aid of maps or each other, tries to locate and write lightly in pencil one of the landmarks mentioned in Sam. 13:

- Michmash
- Bethel
- Gibeah
- Geba
- Gilgal
- Bethaven
- Gad
- Gilead
- Ophrah
- Shual
- Bethhoron
- Zebaim
- Jordan river

(or write on label, and then it can be moved to correct place)
