Subject: Tabernacle

basic supplies:



materials: blue & white string, large needles

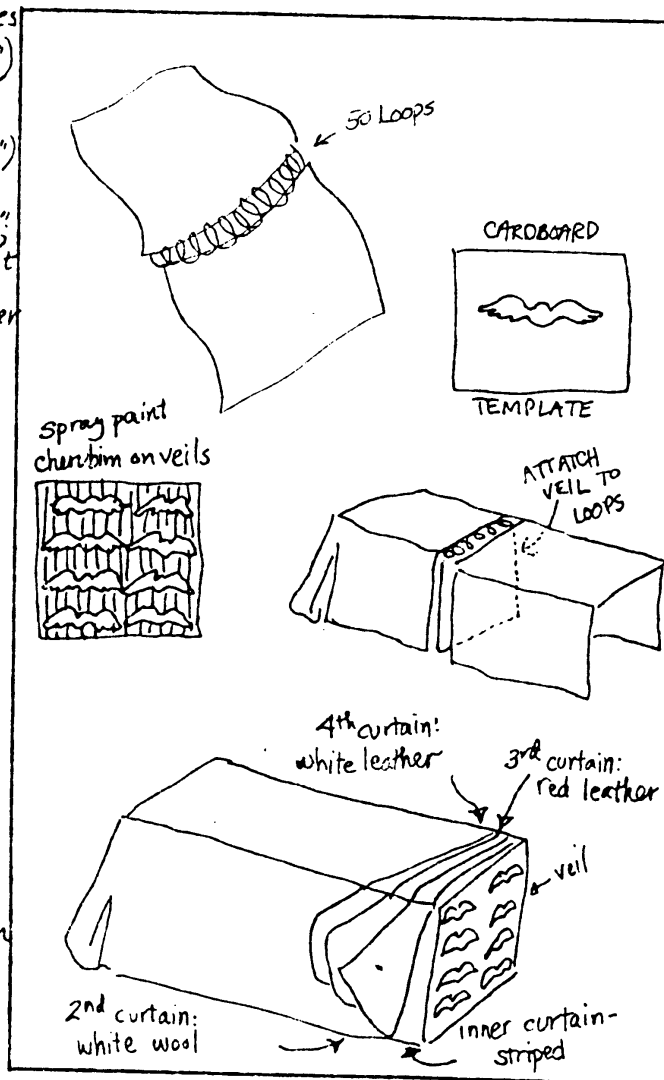
- white or tan leather or fabric ($\approx 30" \times 10"$)
- red leather or fabric ($\approx 30" \times 10"$)
- white wool or fabric ($1-30" \times 20"$, $1-30" \times 24"$)
- striped fabric ~ white, blue, purple, red (or as close to that as you can find) ($2-28" \times 20"$, $2-10" \times 10"$; $1-5" \times 20"$) ; gold spray paint

teacher preparation: cardboard, nails, hammer

- cut out a stencil for the cherubim to spray design on striped fabric
- mark 50 dots along one edge on each of the wool & 1st 2 striped curtains (the 30" or 28" side)

procedure:

- with blue string (or heavy thread) and needle, make loops to sew the 2 striped curtains together
- have another child working on the white wool curtains, using white string to loop them together
- have other children spray paint cherubim on the striped $10" \times 10"$ veils, as well as the striped curtains
- then loop one of the $10" \times 10"$ veils to the middle loops of the striped curtains, such that it will hang down to divide the Holy of Holies from the Holy Place
- attach the 2nd $10" \times 10"$ veil to the 5 poles made the week before, with finishing nails



Notes: Explain that the real curtains were fastened with 50 copper or gold hooks on the loops, and the inner 2 were strips sewn together. This is meant to take 2 weeks, and be coordinated with the other age groups.
